Personal Injuries Assessment Board – Notice regarding on-line applications

<u>Upgraded on-line application form – implications for claimants who have</u> <u>already started to complete an on-line application but have not finalised and</u> submitted it:

If you have started to complete an on-line application form, but have not actually finalised and submitted it, and you intend pursuing an application through the Personal Injuries Assessment Board, you need to finish completing the existing form and submit it before the end of May, 2017.*

As and from the end of May* if you wish to complete an on-line application form you will need to restart your application and input **all** information into the new form.

<u>Upgraded on-line application form – implications for claimants who intend to</u> make an application on-line:

If you wish to make an application on-line before the end of May 2017* you need to complete the existing form fully and submit it before the end of May 2017*. If you partially complete the existing form and do not finalise and submit it before the end of May 2017* you will need to start over again when the new form is live.

As and from the end of May 2017* if you wish to complete an on-line application form, you will need to input **all** information into the new form

The timeframe for making a personal injury application is limited to 2 years in most circumstances so it is important you follow the steps outlined above. If you have any queries, please contact our Service Centre at LoCall 1890 829 121.
